Year in Review

The Year in Review 2017 provides highlights and a snapshot of how QMUNITY has continued to serve BC's queer, trans, and Two-Spirit communities.

Message from the Chair

QMUNITY's story began when a group of individuals, local organizations and businesses came together to open a gay community centre in 1979, holding the first Annual General Meeting in 1980 with a reported 325 members.

A year of opportunity.

Following in the footsteps of those who came before us, we are today looking at our future. During the 2017 International Day Against Homophobia, Transphobia, and Biphobia breakfast the City of Vancouver announced that QMUNITY will have a new, purpose-built facility on the corner of Davie and Burrard.

The announcement of our new home has provided an opportunity for individuals and organizations to re-commit themselves to QMUNITY's vision for a world where LGBTQ/2S folks are empowered to live their lives fully, free from discrimination.

Our work continues.

QMUNITY provides vital programming and services through youth drop-ins, including 'clothing swaps', swimming nights, food prep nights, queer prom; seniors drop-ins, including yoga, information sharing, writing collectives; peer-facilitated groups, including topics like coming out, gender identity, sexuality, and support; and, education and training opportunities such as BC-wide Queer Competency Training workshops and youth-led Pridespeaks.

A year made possible by you.

On behalf of the organization I have been privileged to serve, I want to recognize everyone that works to ensure opportunities abound for LGBTQ/2S folks across BC. Our inspiring volunteers, our dedicated staff, our incredible Board, our generous donors and supporters, our community partners, and everyone that continues to fight for the world we all want to live in--you make this possible.








